STORYLINES

• Delaware advanced to the CAA Tournament Quarterfinals with an 86-79 win over 10th-seeded Elon in a first round game on Saturday night.

• Ryan Daly led the Blue Hens with 23 points, his ninth 20-point effort of the season. Daly has reached double figures in 25 straight games, and is 23 points shy of 1,000 for his career.

• Eric Carter added 20 points and 11 rebounds while posting his 12th double-double of the season. Carter now has 503 career boards, becoming the 32nd player in UD history to surpass 500 career rebounds.

• Ryan Allen contributed 14 points, reaching double figures for the 16th straight game. Allen's 86 three-pointers are tied for the UD single season record, along with John Gordon in 1998-99. Allen has made a three-pointer in all 29 games of his career.

• Anthony Mosley reached double figures for the fifth consecutive game with 13 points. He needs 13 more points to reach the 1,000-point mark for his career.

• Delaware shot 57.4 percent vs. Elon, its second highest percentage of the year.

• The Blue Hens leads the all-time series with Northeastern, 28-26, but the Huskies have won six of the last seven meetings including both regular season matchups this year.

• Tonight's game is the seventh postseason meeting between the schools, including the fifth in the CAA Tournament. Delaware is 4-2 vs. Northeastern in the postseason.

The Blue Hens are 4-8 in 12 CAA Quarterfinal games, and are looking to advance to the CAA Semifinals for the fifth time since joining the league.

Blue Hens Defeat Elon in CAA Tournament 1st Round

Ryan Daly scored 23 points while Eric Carter added a double-double with 20 points and 11 rebounds as the seventh-seeded Delaware defeated 10th-seeded Elon, 86-79, in the first round of the CAA Championship Friday night at the North Charleston Coliseum.

Daly notched his ninth 20-point effort of the season, while Carter recorded his 12th double-double of the campaign. Ryan Allen contributed 14 points and hit three triples to tie the UD single season record for three-pointers made, while Anthony Mosley was the fourth Blue Hen in double figures with 13 points. Delaware shot 57.4 percent from the field and knocked down 18 free throws on the night.

Dmitri Thompson paced Elon with a game-high 27 points, all but five in the second half, while Tyler Seibring chipped in 15 points and nine rebounds.

Elon jumped out to a 10-2 lead five minutes into the game, but Delaware quickly responded to knot the game at 13-13 on a Darian Bryant layup at the 11:10 mark of the half. The Blue Hens then used a nine-point spurt to go up 24-15, and Allen buried consecutive three-pointers in the final minute to give Delaware a 41-30 advantage at the break.

Elon pulled within three points twice early in the second half, the second time at 52-49, but Delaware scored 11 of the next 14 points to go back up 11 on an Allen three-pointer with 11 minutes to play.

The Blue Hens went ahead by as much as 13 twice, the second time at 71-58 at the 5:48 mark, and although the Phoenix closed within five in the final minute, Delaware hit four free throws down the stretch to seal the win.

Delaware vs. Northeastern

Delaware leads the all-time series with Northeastern, 28-26, but the Huskies have won six of the last seven meetings between the schools.

Delaware vs. Northeastern in the Postseason

Tonight's game is the seventh postseason meeting between Delaware and Northeastern, including the fifth in the CAA Tournament. The Blue Hens have won four of the first six postseason matchups.

Delaware in CAA Quarterfinal Games

Delaware is 4-8 during its 12 games in the CAA Tournament Quarterfinals. The Blue Hens have dropped their last two quarterfinal games, a 67-64 loss to Northeastern in 2015 and a 91-82 setback to UNCW last year.

Blue Hens Looking To Advance To CAA Semifinals

A win tonight would advance Delaware to the CAA Tournament Semifinals for just the fifth time since the Blue Hens joined the league in 2001-02.

UD has competed in the CAA Semifinals in 2002, 2003, 2013 and 2014.

Delaware-Northeastern First Meeting

Northeastern used a 12-2 run midway through the second half to take the lead for good and went on to defeat Delaware, 76-64, on Jan. 20 at Matthews Arena.

Donnell Gresham led Northeastern with 17 points, all in the second half, while Vasa Pusica added 16 for Northeastern, which shot 66.7 percent in the second half.

Ryan Daly and Ryan Allen each scored 16 points to lead Delaware, which Anthony Mosley contributed 13 and Skye Johnson chipped in nine.

Both teams struggled from the field in a tight opening first half that featured 14 lead changes. Neither squad led by more than four points in the opening stanza, while a Daly three-pointer from the left corner in the final seconds gave Delaware a 31-28 halftime lead.

Northeastern scored the first six points of the second half to take a 34-31 lead and eventually went up six before the Blue Hens answered with a 9-2 run, going back in front 42-41 on a Daly three-pointer at the 14-minute mark.

However the Huskies countered with eight straight points of their own, taking a 49-42 lead with 11 minutes to play. Daly ended the spurt with a leamer in the lane, but two more Huskies baskets extended the margin to 53-44 with 9:24 left.

Delaware closed within 53-49 after Mosley jumper, but the Huskies then scored seven straight to go up 60-49 with 6:19 to play. Allen hit a three-pointer and then found Mosley for a layup to bring the Blue Hens within 60-55 with 4:12 left, before NU answered with five straight points to go back up double digits and put the game away.

Delaware-Northeastern Second Meeting

Ryan Allen's 18-foot jumper in the final seconds spun off the rim as Delaware fell to Northeastern, 70-67, in a heartbreaker on Feb. 8 at the Bob Carpenter Center.

The Blue Hens trailed by 10 points with 7:42 remaining but closed within a point on an Allen baseline jumper with 1:13 to play. After three consecutive turnovers, Allen pulled up just to the left of the top of the key for an off-balance jumper, but it was just off the mark and the Huskies' Vasa Pusica grabbed the rebound with 1.2 seconds remaining.

Pusica then hit two free throws, before the Blue Hens turned the ball over on a last chance halfcourt pass as Northeastern pulled out the win.

Allen paced Delaware with 19 points on the night, while Eric Carter notched a double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds. Chyree Walker chipped in with nine points, while Anthony Mosley and Skye Johnson contributed eight apiece. The Blue Hens shot 52.9 percent from the field and 11 of 12 from the foul line, but were hurt by a 2 of 11 performance from behind the arc.

Pusica led the Huskies with 27 points including five three-pointers, while Donnell Gresham added 17 points on the night.

The teams went into the half tied at 37-37 and were still knotted at 51-51 with 10:12 to play, but Northeastern scored the next 10 points and led the rest of the way.

Allen Named CAA Rookie of the Year, Daly 3rd Team

Ryan Allen was named the CAA Rookie of the Year while Ryan Daly was selected Third Team All-CAA as the league announced its all-conference teams on Friday.

Allen became the fifth player in Blue Hen history to earn conference Rookie of the Year honors, including the second in a row after Daly claimed the award last season. Delaware is the second school in conference history to earn consecutive CAA Rookie of the Year honors, along with George Mason in 1994 and 1995.

Daly earned third team All-CAA honors for the second year in a row.

Hens Shoot Well vs. Elon

Delaware knocked down 31 of 54 field goal attempts for a 57.4 shooting percentage on Saturday vs. Elon, the team's second highest percentage of the year. The Blue Hens have shot over 50 percent nine times this season, including three of the last four games.

Allen Ties UD Three-Pointers Record

Ryan Allen has now made 86 three-pointers this season, tying the UD single season record.

He ranks second on the CAA freshman three-pointers chart, behind only Brett Blizard of UNCW who hit 94 during the 1999-2000 season.

Allen On Consecutive Games With A Triple Chart

Ryan Allen has made a three-pointer in the first 29 games of his career, the second longest streak in school history. Peca Arsic made a three-pointer in 36 straight games from 1994-96.

Allen Among National Freshman Leaders

Ryan Allen's 86 three-pointers are currently the fifth most by a freshman in Division I. Allen is one of just three rookies in the nation with at least 80 three-pointers and a 15.0 scoring average. The others are RJ Cole of Howard and Trae Young of Oklahoma.

Carter Impressing For Blue Hens

Eric Carter has reached double figures in nine of the last 10 games, including a career-best five straight from Jan. 27 through Feb. 10. Carter has recorded double-doubles in seven of the last 10 games, averaging 13.2 points and 10.3 rebounds while shooting 47 of 73 (64.4%) from the field during that span.

Carter's 12 double-doubles are the third most in the CAA.

Five Blue Hens in Double Figures

Five Blue Hens are currently averaging double figures: Ryan Daly at 17.3 ppg, Ryan Allen at 15.7 ppg, Kevin Anderson at 13.7 ppg, Eric Carter at 11.0 ppg, and Anthony Mosley at 10.5 ppg.

Only four teams in Delaware history have featured five double figure scorers: 1972-73, 1991-92, 1994-95, and 2013-14.

Ryan Daly Surpasses 900-Point Mark

Ryan Daly has scored 977 career points, and is the third player in UD history to reach 900 points in his first two years. He's just the second Blue Hen to surpass the total by the end of his sophomore season.

Carter Among CAA Rebounding Leaders

Eric Carter grabbed 11 rebounds vs. Elon, becoming the 32nd player in UD history to surpass the 500 rebounds mark. He currently ranks third in the CAA with 9.2 rebounds per game, third with 6.8 defensive rebounds per game, and fifth with 2.4 offensive rebounds per game.

Double Figure Streaks

Ryan Daly has reached double figures in 25 consecutive games, and has reached double digits in 49 of the last 52 contests, dating back to Dec. 11, 2016.

Ryan Allen has reached double figures in 25 of the last 27 games, including 16 straight contests.

Daly's streak is currently the second longest in the CAA behind only 52 by Hofstra's Justin Wright-Foreman. Allen's streak in the seventh longest in the conference.

Eric Carter has reached double figures in nine of the last 10 games, including four straight. Anthony Mosley has reached double figures in five consecutive games.

Hens Limiting Turnovers

Delaware ranks second in the CAA and 17th in Division I by committing just 10.8 turnovers per game. The Blue Hens have committed single digit miscues nine times this year, including a season-low tying six at Elon on Feb. 3 and vs. Elon in the CAA Tournament First Round game..

Leave Me In, Coach

Ryan Daly currently ranks second in the CAA and 14th in the nation by averaging 37.4 minutes per game. Ryan Allen ranks sixth in the CAA and 76th in the nation with 35.7 minutes played per game.
