STORYLINES

• Ninth-seeded Delaware will face top-seeded UNCW on Saturday at 12 noon in the CAA Tournament Quarterfinals at North Charleston Coliseum.

• The Blue Hens advanced to the quarterfinals with Friday's 81-76 win over Hofstra in the first round.

• Ryan Daly posted game-highs of 27 points, 11 rebounds, and a career-best six assists during the win. He reached double figures for the 10th straight game, notched his 10th 20-point effort of the year, and recorded his fifth double-double.

• Eric Carter added 19 points, one shy of his career-high, and 10 rebounds to post his second career double-double and his first since the season opener.

• Today's game is the fifth postseason meeting between Delaware and UNCW, with the Seahawks taking the first four. However the teams have not met in the CAA Tournament since 2008.

• UNCW leads the all-time series with Delaware, 21-11, and the Seahawks have won the last four meetings in the series, all by nine points or more.

• Delaware is 4-7 during its 11 games in the CAA Tournament Quarterfinals. The Blue Hens' last appearance in the quarterfinals was a 67-64 loss to Northeastern during the 2015 CAA Tournament.

• Cazmon Hayes is scheduled to play in his 124th career game today, which would tie him for the school record along with Devon Saddler and Jamelle Hagins.

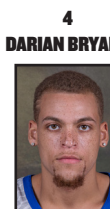

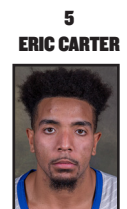

Blue Hens Defeat Hofstra in CAA First Round Game

Delaware rallied back from an eight-point halftime deficit with an impressive second half shooting performance as the Blue Hens posted an 81-76 victory over Hofstra in a CAA Tournament First Round game Friday night at the North Charleston Coliseum.

Ryan Daly, who accepted the CAA Rookie of the Year award prior to the game, again led the way with 27 points, 11 rebounds and a career-high six assists while posting his fifth double-double of the season. Eric Carter also notched a double-double with 19 points and 10 rebounds, while Anthony Mosley contributed 13 points and Cazmon Hayes supplied 10 on the night.

Delaware trailed 47-39 at the half, but hit 15 of its 23 second half field goal attempts to complete the comeback victory. The Blue Hens' 55.6 field goal percentage for the game was the third highest of the season.

Justin Wright-Foreman paced Hofstra with 23 points and knocked down four three-pointers, while Deron Powers chipped in 18 points, Eli Pemberton had 12, and Brian Bernardi scored 11. The Pride connected at a 56.0 percent clip in the opening half, but was limited to 37.9 percent shooting during the final 20 minutes.

The teams were knotted at 29-29 with 4:33 to play in the opening half, but Hofstra scored the next 10 points over a two-minute span and took an eight-point lead into the break.

But Delaware chipped away before eventually pulling even at 54-54 with 14:09 left following a three-pointer by Daly from the top of the key. The Blue Hens took their first lead of the half when Mosley converted a three-point play with 10:45 to go, while a free throw by Carter extended the margin to 66-62 at the 7:55 mark.

Hofstra later scored five straight points to go back in front 72-71, and a Rokas Gustys layup with 2:38 to play tied the game at 74-74. After both teams had two empty possessions Carter hit a jumpshot in the lane, and after a Bernardi miss, Carter added a pair of clutch free throws with 22 seconds left to put Delaware up four.

Powers answered with a layup for the Pride, but after Hayes went one of two from the line, Powers missed a three-pointer before Daly sealed the win by hitting two free throws with four seconds on the clock.

Delaware vs. UNCW

UNCW leads the all-time series with Delaware, 21-11, and the Seahawks have won the last four meetings in the series, all by nine points or more.

Delaware vs. UNCW First Meeting

Delaware poured in its highest scoring output in over a month and shot 60 percent from the field in the second half but it wasn't enough as the Blue Hens dropped a 91-81 back-and-forth CAA barnburner to UNCW at the Bob Carpenter Center on Jan. 7.

UNCW shot 57.7 percent from the field for the game (30 of 52), hit on 13 of 21 shots from the field in the second half, and knocked down a season-high 13 of 31 three-pointers for the game as the Seahawks answered every Blue Hen threat in the second half.

Delaware guard Ryan Daly hit on 10 of 16 shots from the field and finished with a career-high 28 points to go with a team-high six rebounds.

He was joined by three other double-digit scorers as Chivarsky Carbett came off the bench to net a season-high matching 18 points, Anthony Mosley scored 15 points and dished out six assists, and Cazmon Hayes contributed 11 points. Daly's 28 points were the fourth highest single game total ever by a UD freshman.

UNCW placed all five starters in double figures as C.J. Bryce connected for a career-high 27 points on 10 of 14 shooting, Denzel Ingram knocked down five treys and finished with 23 points and a game-high eight assists, Devontae Cacok added 16 points and a game-high 10 rebounds for his sixth double-double of the season, Chris Flemmings contributed 12 points, and Ambrose Mosley chipped in with 11 points and five assists.

UNCW used a 14-0 run over a span of five minutes in the opening half to take a 33-14 lead but the Blue Hens fought back with a 9-1 run of their own and cut the margin to 40-35 at the break. Delaware came out strong in the second half by making its first seven shots and tying things up at 50-50 on a Daly three-pointer with 16:50 left.

But that would be the last share of the lead the Hens would enjoy all night. UNCW followed with a 10-3 run to go up 60-53, before Delaware fought back by scoring six of the next seven points to pull to within two.

But the Seahawks answered with consecutive three-pointers from Ingram and led by at least five points the rest of the way. UNCW knocked down 8 of 15 three-pointers in the second half to keep the Hens at bay.

Delaware vs. UNCW Second Meeting

UNCW knocked down a school-record 21 three-pointers and shot a blistering 69.2 percent from the field as the Seahawks cruised to a 108-80 victory over the Blue Hens at Trask Coliseum on Feb. 4.

The Seahawks went 36 of 52 from the field including 21 of 32 from behind the arc, while handing out 27 assists on the night. Chris Flemmings led the way with 22 points and five three-pointers, while Ambrose Mosley added 18 points on six triples. Devontae Cacok chipped in 17 points, six rebounds and four blocks for UNCW, while Jaylen Fornes also scored a career-high 17 points while going 5 of 6 from deep.

The Seahawks shot 69.2% (36 of 52) from the field, including 65.6% (21 of 32) from three-point range. That field goal percentage is the highest allowed by UD since at least 1983-84 when individual game box scores are available.

Delaware held its own offensively by shooting 52.5 percent from the field, and the Blue Hens posted a 27-23 edge on the glass. Ryan Daly scored 20 points and collected a game-best seven rebounds, while

Eric Carter set his career-high by also scoring 20 points on 9 of 10 shooting from the field. Anthony Mosley came off the bench to score 15 points, while Jacob Cushing added a career-high 11 points.

Delaware hung with the Seahawks early on, as a three-point play by Mosley gave the Blue Hens an 18-17 lead at the 11:55 mark of the opening half. UD was still down just a pair at 25-23 a minute and a half later, but UNCW went on a 14-4 spurt to take a 39-27 advantage on a Fornes triple.

The Blue Hens answered with six straight points to pull within six before the Seahawks closed the period with a 15-4 run, capped with a last second three-pointer by Denzel Ingram, to increase the margin to 54-37 at the break.

Delaware shot 60.7 percent during the opening half, but UNCW connected on a blistering 70.4 percent in the first stanza, including an 11 of 16 performance from behind the arc.

UNCW then used a seven-point run to go up 69-44 and force a Blue Hen timeout with 14:01 remaining, and led by at least 18 points the rest of the way.

Delaware allowed its highest point total since a 113-111 overtime loss at New Hampshire on Feb. 26, 1995, and its eighth most points ever in a regulation game.

Daly Named CAA Rookie of Year, 3rd Team All-CAA

Ryan Daly was named the CAA Rookie of the Year and was selected Third Team All-CAA as the league announced its all-conference teams Thursday night.

Daly became the fourth player in Blue Hen history to earn conference Rookie of the Year honors, along with Anthony Wright (ECC in 1989-90), Brian Pearl (NAC in 1991-92) and Devon Saddler (CAA in 2010-11). Additionally, he is the first player in Delaware history to earn all-conference accolades during his freshman season.

Blue Hen sophomore guard Curtis Lochner, a Dean's List student as a health behavior science major, represented Delaware on the CAA All-Academic Team.

Hayes Set To Tie UD Games Played List

Tonight Cazmon Hayes is expected to appear in his 124th career game, which would tie him for first place in UD history along Devon Saddler and Jamelle Hagins.

Hayes Reaches 1,000 Points

Cazmon Hayes scored five points during the regular season finale at Elon to become the 33rd player in school history to reach the 1,000-point mark. He moved into 32nd place after scoring 10 points last night vs. Hofstra.

Hens Put Up Points vs. UNCW

Delaware reached the 80-point mark four times on the season, but two of those games came against UNCW. (The Blue Hens also scored 84 points during the win over Division III Bryn Athyn on Nov. 27 and 81 during last night's victory over Hofstra.)

Delaware shot a combined 54.0% during its two games with UNCW, but the Seahawks shot an incredible 63.5%, including 54.0% (34 of 63) from behind the arc.

Daly Sets UD Freshman Scoring, Rebounding Records

With Ryan Daly's game-winning three-pointer vs. Drexel on Feb. 16, he became the leading freshman scorer in school history. He then became UD's leading freshman rebounder after grabbing seven boards on Feb. 18 vs. William & Mary.

Daly Continues To Shine

Ryan Daly posted game-highs of 18 points and 12 rebounds while notching his first career double-double during the Dec. 28 win over Iona. He then added his second straight double-double with game-highs of 20 points and 15 boards vs. Hofstra on Dec. 31.

Daly is just the second freshman in school history to record consecutive double-doubles, along with Greg Smith in 1993-94.

Daly has reached double figures in 22 of the last 24 games, reaching the 20-point mark 10 times in that stretch. He has led the Blue Hens in scoring in 17 of the last 21 contests.

Daly Posts Consecutive 20-Point Games Again

Prior to this season, just one UD freshman in school history had scored 20 points in consecutive games: Devon Saddler, who scored 29 at Rider on Feb. 19, 2011 and 20 vs. Towson four days later.

Ryan Daly has accomplished that feat three times this season. He scored 20 points in consecutive home games against Hofstra on Dec. 31 and Charleston on Jan. 2. Daly then scored 27 points during the Jan. 19 win over Northeastern, before adding 21 on Jan. 21 vs. Towson.

Daly scored 24 points on Feb. 16 vs. Drexel and added 20 two nights later against William & Mary.

Daly Reaching 20 Points

Ryan Daly scored a team-high 27 points last night vs. Hofstra, the 10th time this season he has reached the 20-point mark.

He is the only UD freshman in school history to post 10 20-point games; Jarvis Threatt recorded four games of at least 20 points in 2011-12.

Carter Posts 2nd Career Double-Double vs. Hofstra

Eric Carter posted his second career double-double, and his first since this year's season opener vs. Goldey-Beacom, by scoring 19 points and grabbing 10 rebounds during Friday's win over Hofstra.

Carter's 19 points were one shy of his career-high of 20 set at UNCW on Feb. 4.

UD Starter Log Minutes vs. Hofstra

Fatigue could become a factor in today's game, as all five Blue Hen starters played at least 33 minutes during last night's win over Hofstra. Ryan Daly played all 40 minutes vs. the Pride.

Hayes Moving Up Three-Point Lists

Cazmon Hayes has attempted 471 triples during his career, ninth most in UD history. Hayes has made 137 career three-pointers, putting him in 10th place in Blue Hen history.
