As a Blue Hen

Co-captain this season...has 18 double-figure scoring games in his career...lost a season of eligibility after transferring from Minnesota per NCAA rules, although he was never on the basketball roster; was recruited by the Gophers to play football, but did not play in 1998-99...has appeared in all 60 games in his Delaware career...**2001-02 Season:** Became first guard to lead UD in rebounding (records begin with the 1950-51 season)...shot a team-best 84.5% from the free throw line (No. 2 in the CAA behind VCU's Willie Taylor)...led Delaware in rebounding 14 times, including four double-figure games...recorded seven double-figure scoring games...had an outstanding CAA Tourney with 29 points (14.5 ppg) on 11-20 shooting from the field and 12 rebounds, nine assists and five steals...**2000-01 Season:** Scored a career-high 20 points off the bench in UD's America East semifinal win over Northeastern (7 for 10 from the field, including 4 for 5 from three-point range) in just 21 minutes of action...appeared in all 30 games, 29 of them off of the bench...played no less than 14 minutes in a game...finished among the America East leaders in steals, three-point field goal percentage and assist/turnover ratio...tied for team lead in steals (52) and was team's second-leading rebounder...set UD rookie record with 46 three-pointers...had 11 straight games with a three-pointer...had 11 games scoring in double-figures...recorded one double-double - at New Hampshire Jan. 25 (12 pts., 10 rebounds)...became the 12th player at UD to record 50 steals in a season...had seven games with five or more assists...had 15 points in overtime loss at College of Charleston...**1999-2000 Season:** Sat out per NCAA transfer rules after transferring from U. of Minnesota.

1998-99 Season: Sat out season as a redshirt on the University of Minnesota football team.

High School

Set career records at Eden Prairie High School for points (1,740), rebounds (696) and steals (250)...four-time Lake Conference All-Academic selection...was named Midwest SportsChannel's (MSC) Boys' High School Athlete of the Year as a senior...Associated Press Football Player of the Year as a senior in 1997...Finalist for Minnesota's Mr. Basketball Award as a senior in 1997-98...two-time all-state selection in football as he led team to back-to-back state titles (caught the winning TD pass in both state title games)...football team was a perfect 13-0 in his senior season as he recorded 142 tackles...played strong safety and linebacker on defense and tight end on offense.
