Delaware on the Air

This season will be the first year that all University of Delaware men's basketball games will be carried on flagship station WRDX 94.7 FM. Also on the Blue Hen radio network are WDOV-AM 1410 (Dover) and WTGM-AM (Salisbury, MD). Mike Corey and Bill Kommissaroff, who enter their sixth year on the network, return to call the action.

In addition, most UD basketball games are also broadcast on the university student station, WVUD-FM 91.3, and WVUD2, the station's internet radio network.

Real Audio links for both broadcasts are available through UD's athletics website.

Delaware is scheduled to play four games on television this season. The Blue Hens' game at Hofstra on January 22 will be televised by Fox Sports Net-New York, while both the February 19 home game with the Pride and the February 22 game at Drexel will be broadcast by the Colonial Athletic Association Network. Both of those games are scheduled to be shown on both Comcast SportsNet-Philadelphia and Mid-Atlantic. Delaware's season-opener at Ohio State was broadcast by ESPN Plus.

Additionally, all Delaware home games are shown on STN, the student television network that is shown on campus.

Delaware vs. Drexel

Delaware has played Drexel more than any other opponent in school history, and the Blue Hens hold a slim 66-62 advantage in the all-time series. Delaware is 43-21 against the Dragons in Newark, including a 9-4 mark in the Bob Carpenter Center.

Last season Drexel posted an 82-75 win in Philadelphia on January 15, as Sean Brooks scored a team-high 22 points. Mike Ames scored 30 points for the Blue Hens, while **Mike Slattery** posted a double-double with 10 points and 10 assists.

The teams met again in the BCC in the Blue Hens' regular season finale, when Delaware recorded a 76-64 victory over Drexel. **Harding Nana** exploded for a career-high 28 points and pulled down 10 rebounds to post his fourth straight double-double in that win.

Delaware Finishes Strong On West Coast

The Blue Hens trailed by double-digit margins during the second half of both games last week, but did not quit. Delaware trailed St. Mary's (CA), 63-40, with 10:40 remaining, but closed the game on an 18-4 run to cut the final margin to nine. The Blue Hens were down 65-49 to San Francisco with just 8:32 to play, but used a 25-12 run to get within 77-74 with 50 seconds remaining. Delaware again pulled within three at 82-79 with three seconds left before the Dons' John Cox put the game away with a pair of free throws.

Blue Hens Dominate Inside vs. Mountaineers

Delaware outscored Mount St. Mary's, 34-14, in points in the paint during its 71-49 victory on November 27, and shot extremely well from the field. The Blue Hens, who shot close to 70 percent through the first 30 minutes of the game, finished 28-of-39 from inside the arc (71.8 percent). In fact, Delaware, which shot 58.5 percent for the game despite hitting just 3-of-14 three-point attempts, missed the same number of two-point shots as three-point attempts.

Nana Starts With A Bang

Junior **Harding Nana**, who posted double-doubles in the final four regular season games last season, has started strong this year. Nana has led the Blue Hens in scoring in four of the first five games this season, including team-highs of 21 points at St. Mary's (CA) and 20 at San Francisco last week.

Nana was 9-of-12 from the field against Mount St. Mary's, hitting his first six shots from the field. He also hit his final two shots at Ohio State, and his eight consecutive field goals made are the sixth-most in Delaware history.

At Loyola last Monday, Nana pulled down a career-high 14 rebounds and hit two free throws with 20 seconds remaining to put Delaware up four.

In Thursday's game at St. Mary's (CA) Nana hit 9-of-13 shots from the field, and posted his first double-double of the season with a 20-point, 10-rebound performance at San Francisco.

He currently leads the team with 16.6 points per game and 7.8 rebounds per game.

Washington Contributes Immediately

Junior **Andrew Washington**, who played his first two seasons at Allen Community College in Kansas, has made an immediate impact in his first year with the Blue Hens. Washington, who has started all five games this season, currently ranks second on the team with 12.0 points per game. Washington scored 10 points in his Delaware debut at Ohio State, and led the Blue Hens with 26 points in the 63-60 win at Loyola (MD) last Monday. He scored 14 points on 7-of-14 shooting and added a career-high six rebounds at San Francisco.

On The Road Again

Delaware is certainly racking up the frequent flier miles early this season. The Blue Hens traveled 770 round trip miles to Columbus, OH for their season-opener at Ohio State, and last weekend flew 2503 miles to and from San Francisco, CA. Next Saturday Delaware will fly 1575 miles to Puerto Rico, and make the return trip home Thursday, December 23. Add in a 104-mile round trip bus ride to Loyola (MD), and by the time the holidays arrive the Blue Hens will have traveled 9030 miles and made three plane trips.

Struggling From Outside

The Blue Hens shot 36.7 percent from three-point range last season, but have struggled from behind the arc early this year. Delaware entered the San Francisco game just 10-of-59 from long distance, but showed signs of coming out of the slump by shooting 8-of-19 against the Dons. Still, the Blue Hens are just 18-of-78 (23.1 percent) from three-point range this season, last in the conference. Among those still looking to find their shooting stroke are **Harding Nana** (4-22, 18.2), **Andrew Washington** (1-11, 11.1), and **Rulon Washington** (4-17, 23.5).

Slattery, Nana Earn Preseason Recognition

Mike Slattery was a first team Preseason All-CAA selection by *Street & Smith's*, *Lindy's*, and *CBS Sportsline* magazines, and was a second team pick by *The Sporting News*. Additionally, Slattery was named the league's Top Playmaker by *Street & Smith's*, while junior **Harding Nana** was named first team Preseason All-CAA by *The Sporting News*.

Blue Hens Enter 100th Year

The 2004-05 season marks the 100th year for the Delaware men's basketball program. Including this season, the Blue Hens have posted an overall record of 991-1048-2 in their first century of basketball, have made four trips to the NCAA Tournament and one to the Postseason NIT, and have won 20 games six times, the last coming during **David Henderson's** first season in 2000-01 when UD went 20-10.

Mister Assister

Mike Slattery took over the starting point guard spot during the second half of his freshman year, and finished the season with 94 assists.

He led the CAA and ranked 18th in in Division I with 6.2 assists per game as a sophomore, while playing 35.7 minutes per game.

Last season Slattery again led the league while ranking 21st in the nation with 5.9 assists per game, and also led the conference with a 2.34 assist/turnover ratio.

Since taking over the starting spot, in 74 starts Slattery has 425 assists and just 186 turnovers for a 2.28 assist/turnover ratio. In those 74 starts, he has had more turnovers than assists just six times, and has seven games with 10 or more assists in his career.

Slattery is the fourth player in UD history to record 400 career assists, and only the second to do it before his senior season. He currently ranks third at Delaware with 467 career assists.

Against UNC Greensboro during his sophomore year Slattery posted a career-high 15 assists, the most by a Blue Hen in 20 years, tied for the second-highest single-game total in UD history, and a Carpenter Center record. In that game, Slattery played all 40 minutes and had 15 assists versus just one turnover. The 15 assists were also one shy of the CAA record. He dupli-

cated that performance in UD's home win over William & Mary, making Slattery one of two players in the nation to record multiple 15-assist games.

Delaware Bench-Marks

David Henderson has used his bench a lot during his tenure at Delaware.

During Henderson's five seasons at UD, the Blue Hen bench has scored in double figures in 114 of 122 games. Delaware's bench had scored in double figures in 71 straight games until being held to just eight points in the Blue Hens' 80-66 win over James Madison on January 12, 2004.

In the 2001-02 season, UD's bench averaged 28.3 points per game and scored 20 or more points in 27 of 30 games, while in 2002-03 Delaware's bench averaged 25.1 points per game, 8.4 more than the opposition.

Last season Delaware got 20 or more points from its bench in 18 games.

This season the UD bench has scored in double figures in four of five games and is averaging 12.6 points per game, while the Blue Hens' opponents are averaging 17.2 points per game.

Long Distance Plan

Delaware has made at least one three-point field goal in each of the last 414 games dating back to November 28, 1990. In all, the Blue Hens have made one three-pointer in all but five games (524 of 529) since the implementation of the three-point line throughout the NCAA in 1986-87. Delaware's streak has been in jeopardy lately, as the Blue Hens hit just 1-of-13 three-point attempts against Loyola (MD) and went just 2-of-11 from behind the arc against St. Mary's (CA).

Reaching No. 10

Delaware has won at least 10 games in 22 straight seasons, dating back to 1981-82. Drexel, which has won 10 or more games in 30 consecutive years, is the only CAA school with a longer streak.

Slattery Moving Up UD Career Charts

Mike Slattery has appeared in all 92 games at Delaware and has started 74 consecutive contests, just eight shy of the Delaware record of 82 set by Taurence Chisholm from 1984 through 1988 and Mike Ames from 2000 through 2004. Slattery ranks third on the UD list with 467 career assists and is in ninth place on the CAA all-time chart. He also ranks 12th in Delaware history with 292 career three-pointers attempted and 14th with 102 made, is 14th with 2,751 career minutes played, and 37th with 827 career points. Slattery currently ranks ninth at UD with 135 career steals.

Home Sweet Home

Delaware has enjoyed tremendous success at the Bob Carpenter Center since the building opened prior to the 1992-93 season.

The Blue Hens have won 76 of their last 92 games on their home floor and are 128-35 (.785) at home in the BCC's 12 seasons.

That success has continued under David Henderson, as Delaware is 40-14 (.741) at home during Henderson's tenure.

UD has lost consecutive home games just four times since the BCC opened in December 1992 and has never lost three straight at home at the BCC.
