

# DELAWARE CHALLENGE 2009

## INFORMATION FOR SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 15

- All Players must check in first at Registration Tent behind Delaware Field House at Turf Fields.....
- Teams can use their club team or school number jerseys but need to email [bobshil@udel.edu](mailto:bobshil@udel.edu) with accurate roster by Nov 13  
Delaware Challenge Reversible Jerseys with numbers will be given out at the first game at the field by field managers.
- Jersey Numbers will correspond to information in college recruiting booklet for college recruiters.

### DIRECTIONS: By Car

#### From the north:

Take I-95 South to Delaware Exit 1-B; Route 896 North, which becomes South College Avenue at the intersection of Route 4. Continue straight approximately two miles on South College Avenue (past Fred P. Rullo Stadium, the Bob Carpenter/Sports Convocation Center, Delaware Stadium, and the Delaware Field House - Delaware Field House is the check in facility = Looks like Airplane Hangar ).

#### From the south:

Take I-95 North to Delaware Exit 1; Route 896 North, which becomes South College Avenue at the intersection of Route 4. Continue straight approximately two miles on South College Avenue (past Fred P. Rullo Stadium, the Bob Carpenter/Sports Convocation Center, Delaware Stadium, and the Delaware Field House - Delaware Field House is the check in facility = Looks like Airplane Hangar ).

**From the west:** Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike East to Route 283 South. Continue on Route 283 South, which becomes Route 30 East outside of Lancaster, to Route 896 South. As you reach campus and cross the railroad tracks, immediately turn left onto Delaware Avenue and right (at the second traffic light) onto South College Avenue. Continue straight on South College Avenue to Delaware Field House - that is the check in facility = Looks like Airplane Hangar

### Additional Information:

- Trainers will be on every field – but players are responsible for their own water bottles. Trainers are responsible to provide treatment if an injury occurs on the field during play but not responsible for preventive taping
- Bring both sneakers or turf (nubs) shoes for Rullo Stadium and molded/screw in cleats for field turf.
- Rosters will be emailed by November 13 so any player signing up as an independent – please find which team you are on for registration purposes, check in time and familiarity with the game schedule. Due to some state association rules – several high school teams are not listed by their school names.
- Mixed teams were balanced to provide the depth for teams to compete for 3 games during the day
- Included is a map of the fields being used for the tournament
- Game format and tournaments rules will be on the schedule. Teams will be placed in 4 Divisions with 4 to a division. Best record out of 3 games played will win that Division. Any ties then Divisional Co-Champs. There will not be an overall champion. Divisional winners only.
- Please wear your numbered school or club jerseys or the Delaware Challenge numbered reversible jersey that will be given at the field for groups needing reversibles for college coaches in attendance.
